**NORTHBOUND INTERSTATE 75 TO CLOSE BRIEFLY BETWEEN
CORKSCREW ROAD AND ALICO ROAD TONIGHT DECEMBER 17, 2008 TO
MOVE A CRANE**

FORT MYERS, FL (December 17, 2008) – As part of its on-going project to construct the Estero Parkway Extension over Interstate 75, Lee County's contractor ZEP Construction will be moving a crane from the median of Interstate 75 to the east side between Corkscrew Road and Alico Road beginning at 2:30 a.m. This action will require the closure of the northbound lanes of the interstate, which will include the northbound on-ramp from Corkscrew Road to I-75. The closure will be done with the assistance of law enforcement using a rolling roadblock beginning south of Corkscrew Road. The entire process should be completed within thirty minutes.
