Cape Coral City Council member joins Lee County Tourist Development Council

LEE COUNTY, FL – The Lee County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) appoints Cape Coral City Council member Chris Chulakes-Leetz to the Lee County Tourist Development Council (TDC) effective today.

Chulakes-Leetz has been a Cape Coral resident since 1997. He attended Chemeketa College in Oregon and Governor's State University in Illinois earning his bachelor's degree in business and psychology.

For 20 years, Chulakes-Leetz served as a paramedic and firefighter. He currently holds a position as a residential real estate associate. Chulakes-Leetz is involved in several not-for-profit organizations including Pets are Working Saints (PAWS), Compassionate Friends, and Grace Methodist Church.

He will replace Cape Coral Councilwoman Delores Bertolini.

Furthermore, County Commissioner Tammy Hall has been reappointed as TDC chairwoman.

The nine-member TDC was established by the BOCC in 1983 to increase tourism to Lee County.
