**City of Fort Myers-** N/A

**City of Bonita Springs-** *New City Manager, due to the retirement of long-time City manager Gary Price, is Carl Schwing for the City of Cape Coral. 6400 # per quarter of material was removed for the storm drain inserts. The City has purchased a spill response Training Video...see Dave Liccardi if interested in borrowing. City has been investigating Illicit Discharges (Industrial) power washing trucks resulting in discharges of ATF and motor oil residuals into the groundwater.*

**City of Cape Coral-** *Most recently there has been an investigation of a Marble cutting operation discharging cutting and turbid waste water. There has been a City reorganization...Public Works has been reorganized to improve efficiency and reduce staffing. Environmental Resources will remain in Public Works. Storm Water Master Plan consultant chosen...CDM.*

**City of Sanibel-** *Annual Report period completed and currently putting records together.*

**Town of Fort Myers Beach-** N/A

**East County Water Control-** *5 culverts have been replaced in house, Sailfish 2 almost done, starting Sailfish 3 soon. The new Sailfish structures have better flow control, elevation improvement and reduced leakage.*

**San Carlos Estates WCD-** *Stilwell weir issues, leakage and bypassing, may pressure grout to resolve.*

**CDDs-**

- **Items of Interest:**

- 1) IFAS wrote letter to Mack Hatcher in Collier concerning the value of fertilization during summer to sustain high growth period and reduce fall runoff discharges of nutrients due to poor plant health.
- 2) The current thinking is to follow the same NPDES MS4 permit boundaries as the original 1998 permit issued by EPA. If there are special or mitigating circumstances, this will be addressed by the FDEP as conditions to the permit. The timing of the permit issuance is not finalized. However, the permit should be out in 30 days. A notice of the Intent to Issue will be sent to Lee County and forwarded to the co-permittees. The Intent to Issue should follow within 10 days.
