**INSTRUCTIONS FOR ESTABLISHING NEW FEES  
OR  
REVISING EXISTING FEES  
(External Fees and Charges Manual)**

**Administrative Code 3-10**

External Fees and Charges are hereby established by **Resolution Number 01-02-45** on 02/27/01.

**TO ESTABLISH A NEW EXTERNAL FEE OR TO REVISE AN EXISTING EXTERNAL FEE:**

The County Manager has been given the authority to revise or add, without further Board approval, the following fees and charges:

All fees excluding those established by County ordinance or resolution, those concerning Constitutional Officers and those for Community Development.

To **establish a new fee**, requesting Department will submit a draft of the new fee along with the Internal/External Fees Manual pink sheet to the County Manager. After approval, the County Manager will forward the completed draft and signed pink sheet to Public Resources to update External Fees Manual. Public Resources will update the manual with the new fee and distribute to appropriate departments.

To **revise an existing fee**, requesting Department will send the current page with revisions marked in red and the Internal/External Fees Manual pink sheet to the County Manager. After approval, the County Manager will forward the corrected page and signed pink sheet to Public Resources to update External Fees Manual. Public Resources will update the manual with the revisions and distribute to appropriate departments.

### **WATER SYSTEM CONNECTION CAPACITY FEES**

A. Residential Connection (capacity) Fees shall be based on a table for Equivalent Residential Units. The actual connection fee shall be calculated by multiplying the number of ERU's designated, times the class of ERU. The connection fee will be based upon the actual type of use or user category of each unit on site, regardless of any other designated uses. The Commercial and Non-Residential Connection (capacity) Fee shall be used on the flow rates as outlined in Florida Administrative Code Chapter 64E-6.008. The resulting gallons per day flow

contribution as outlined in FAC Chapter 64E-6.008 will then be multiplied by the respective rate per gallon as defined in Paragraph D below.

- B. No person, corporation, partnership or any other legal entity shall be allowed to connect onto the Lee County Water and Sewer System without first receiving a formal approval from the County and the payment of all applicable Connection Fees.
- C. The County reserves the right to review the amount of water and/or sewer usage during the course of a customer's service, and shall bill the owner or customer for any adjustment(s) to the water and/or sewer Connection Fees for capacity use which is in excess of the amount originally paid for by the owner or customer. Any additional Connection Fee payments shall be billed separately to the owner or customer at the same rate that was initially charged at the time of service application.
- D. The Connection Fee rate schedule set forth below shall be applicable to all customers of the Lee County Water and Sewer System.
  - a. In addition to the physical connection to, and the installation of a meter for the determination of consumption for both water and sewer system, the County shall charge a connection fee which represents the capital facility cost of the water and sewer system capacity utilized by the new connection.
  - b. The capital cost of the water and sewer capacity is calculated on an Equivalent Residential Unit (ERU) basis, which is defined as the maximum demand of two hundred fifty (250) gallons per day (GPD) which equates to the demand for a single-family dwelling unit.
  - c. In no instance shall an ERU determination of less than one (1.0) be assigned to any individual applicant (connection) for water and/or wastewater service (exclusive of individual multi-family or recreational vehicle dwelling units).

If research of the records is required to fulfill a request, the lawful fee for such research shall be charged. If the custodian determines that the cost of the copies will exceed \$50.00, the custodian may request that the requester submit a deposit prior to preparing the copies. Custodians are not required to give out information from the records, to interpret them, or to set forth records or information in a certain format as requested by the requester.
3. Requesters are encouraged to present their requests to Lee Cares, Courthouse Administration Building, to expedite the request. Staff there will assist in obtaining the desired information, or direct the requester to the custodian of the particular documents. However, requesters may contact the custodian directly if so desired.
4. Custodians of public records will respond to requests for information on a first come first serve basis. Due to the nature of the request, response time on some requests may be longer than on others, but all will be handled as soon as reasonably possible.
5. All inspections shall be conducted during normal business hours in the presence of the custodian or a designee. The records shall always be retained in the control of the custodian or his designee unless otherwise required by law.
6. Upon completing the inspection of the records, the requester shall identify which, if any, documents he desires copies. If no inspection of the records has been requested, the requester may otherwise identify which copies of documents he desires. Copies will be made as soon as reasonably possible.
7. Any disputes, which may arise out of the custodian's determination that certain records are exempt or are not public records shall be referred to the County Attorney for a determination.

- e) Overheads-based on a multiplier on direct labor equal to 2.35, to cover labor fringes and other overhead and GIS charges.
