

INFORMATIONAL MEETING OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE
CHERRY LANE BLUEBERRY LANE MSBU, MARCH 20, 2009

Time: 1:15 p.m.,.

Attending: Chas. Mohar, Chairman; Lee McCall, Vice Chair.;
Board Members Morgan Porter, Terry Ashby and Altenate, Cindy
Bickford.

Meeting was called to discuss resealing both Cherry and
Blueberry Lanes. Questions were asked regarding the value of
the process, and cost of it. Bids have been solicited from two
companies, PMI Pavement Maintenance, and Cougar Contracting,
both in Ft. Myers, FL.

Three years elapsed since the last sealing of Cherry,
and both streets show many cracks to indicate the need for
repair. In regard to the cost, this is financed through the
assessment by Lee County, and the money is available. Choosing
the best company is the next task of the Board.

Examples of the work of each company are to be seen
locally; Pinewood Cove, is one. Quotations are:
PMI, cleaning the old surface, and putting down two coats of
sealer, (both streets) \$8,985.00. COUGAR, one coat of "Genseal",
for both streets, \$7,780.00.

These examples will be discussed at the Annual Board
Meeting April 1, 2009. The County receives a discount, so the
amounts may vary. It was suggested the American Legion be
contacted to seek a recommendation from their recent paving
job.

Some complaints regarding the situation of standing water
at the entrance of the streets were unresolved- as was the
problem of trucks violating the right-of-way at the culde-sac
and destroying the edges.

Chairman Mohar asked for a replacement for Josephine
Williams, who has left the area, Cindy Bickford offered to serve
in her place as an alternate on Cherry Lane.

Meeting adjourned at 2:10 p.m. by Chairman Mohar.
