

**Tanglewood Neighborhood MSTU Board**  
**Minutes of the July 16, 2009 meeting, Thursday, 7:00 pm**

The members of the Tanglewood MSTU Committee met at the home of Secretary Mary Richey at 7 pm. Present were chair Anne Flaughner, Dave Morrow, Dave Ceilley, Keith Gomez and Secretary Mary Richey.

Guests were President of the TRA Wendy Gault and TRA treasurer Beverly Herter, and Gil Richey.

**Minutes** Minutes were read and the following corrections made; TRA Vice President Jeff Caccamise's last name was omitted. TRA treasurer Beverly Haueter's name was misspelled. Also, under New Business the fact that the \$5000 landscape plan proposed by the TRA was to be paid by the TRA.

**New Business** - Mary Richey reported that she had discussed the dead oak in the median with John Sibley. She felt it was not timely to replant because of the drought and the lack of a close source of water. She will be responsible for checking on the monthly work done by All Native Plants.

**Old Business** - Secretary Richey read an account of the Committee's landscaping goals, and of the Landscaping Grant that we won from Lee county. The Department of Transportation requires that we maintain adequate visibility at intersections. The first median at Tanglewood and McGregor must be cut to a maximum of 18 inches 25 feet from the center of McGregor.

Mrs. Gault presented the Rohaley plan again. Discussion ensued. It was decided to table the meeting and meet at 9 o'clock on Saturday morning, the 18<sup>th</sup>, at the main entrance to walk the plantings and discuss and make decisions about what could or should be moved and/or removed, and what might be used to replace the removals.

**Saturday, July 18, 2009 -**

Meeting at the Tanglewood Entrance at 9:00 AM were Dave Ceilley, Keith Gomez, Mary Richey and Wendy Gault.

We began at the Brentwood Entrance, and looked at each plant, discussed the suitability to location as well as aesthetic appeal. Then we went on to the Tanglewood Entrance and repeated our examination of the plantings.

We decided to begin by removing plants that were dead and plants that were not doing well in their location. This removal will give us a better view of the potential for redesign and replanting .

Mrs. Gault will contact Rohaley and get a hourly rate for removal and haul away. Mrs. Richey will contact Ameratech and Vilmar Ribiero for similar hourly rate bids.

We will discuss results of the bids. We want removal to be accomplished under supervision.

We adjourned at approximately 10:00 AM.
